

CV Claudia Fahrenwald

Dr. Claudia Fahrenwald is a Professor of Organizational Education and School Development at the University of Education Upper Austria in Linz. Originally from Germany, she studied philosophy and comparative literature at Munich, Berlin and Augsburg. She received her PhD in Philosophy and Comparative Literature in 1999 and her second PhD in Education in 2011 from the University of Augsburg. Before coming to Austria, she worked in 2000-2002 at the Research Group for Gender Studies at the University of Augsburg. In 2003-2011, she worked as an Assistant Professor at the Department of Adult Education at the University of Augsburg, and in 2011-2013 as a Visiting Professor for Education and School Development at the University of Hamburg. Her current areas of interest are civic engagement education, organizational education, leadership and gender. She conducts research projects combining organizational learning theories and civic engagement education concepts. She is currently working in an international "Civic Education Project", in collaboration with three other EU countries (Great Britain, Poland, Estonia), Israel and Georgia. She has also published many articles and chapters and has authored, co-authored or edited seven books including Gender and Education, Narrative within New Learning Cultures, Organization and Participation, and Organization and Civil Society. Her current research focuses on civic engagement education, organizational education and school development as well as gender and education. Additionally, she is head of the Executive Board of the Division for Organizational Education in the German Educational Research Association (GERA).
